- New Planting Convenience: Chateau EZ provides early protection of new plantings from weeds. It can be applied immediately after planting according to label guidelines.
 - Almonds, pistachios, walnuts, stone fruits, pome fruits, grapes, grapefruit, lemons, oranges, tangerines, olives, avocados, pomegranates and figs
- ▶ **Broad Spectrum:** controls **more than 90** annual broadleaf and grass weeds, including marestail, fleabane, mallow, filaree, annual ryegrass and other annual grasses

How To Use

Rate	12 fl oz per broadcast acre application. Apply up to 24 fl oz/A per year.				
Burn Down	Use a registered burndown herbicide to control existing weeds				
Timing	Chateau EZ may be applied immediately after planting of trees that are protected from spray contact				
Method	Apply a uniform broadcast spray. Direct spray to the orchard floor and the base of tree trunks. Ensure uniform coverage across the entire berm.				
Spray Volume	Minimum of 15 gallons of spray solution per acre				
Adjuvant	Per recommendation of tank mix partner				
PHI	60 days for all crops with bearing label; non-bearing citrus and avocado fruit may not be harvested for 1 year				
REI	12 hours

Other Important Information—See Label for Complete Information

- ▶ Chateau EZ requires at least ¼ inch of irrigation or rainfall for activation
- Apply a maximum of 6 fl oz/A per application on any soil that has more than 80% sand plus gravel content if trees are less than 3 years of age
- Follow instructions for spray tank clean out immediately after use. See label for details.
- In certain areas in San Joaquin, Stanislaus and Merced counties, almond growers must follow specific timing, soil type, pH and moisture requirements. See label for details.
- ▶ Other residual herbicides can be added to a tank mix to control weeds not listed on *Chateau* EZ label
